

Report - June 2013 – December 2013

Dear friends and Donors,

As the year 2013 is going to end, we would like to present an overall report about the happenings and development in school, boarding and WE group. Of course we send the report every quarter whatever happened but this is an overall report of the year so that you may know and believe your valuable help has not gone in vain and has been utilized for the purpose for which we work together.

SCHOOL:

New ventures:

*We purchased newly 10 lap tops and presented to computer lab on 9th July. The computer science students benefit a lot from this.

* Doors for all the cub boards in all class rooms have been fixed. The total number of class rooms are 28. Also we replaced new doors for staff toilets(Both for men and women). Likewise, new doors were replaced for students toilets too(16 doors for boys and 10 doors for girls toilets).

* As we know games is part of education , in order to promote the students to develop their skills in various games we purchased play materials for more than one lakh.

* A new fencing has been made around the water tank shed.

*We applied and got new telephone connection for both school and boarding. This helps very much for communication for the better administration. In the boarding students parents could communicate or they call to this number and talk to their children.

REPAIR WORKS IN THE SCHOOL:

*We have fixed fans for all the class rooms and we repaired a few fans which could be repaired.

* In the ground floor we removed all the wires and put new cables.

STAFF APPOINTMENTS:

We can proudly say that we have enough teaching and non teaching staff for our school. This year we appointed five teaching staff and five non teaching staff to our school.

ACHIEVEMENTS:

Our students excel in various fields like volley ball, chess, kho-kho, kabadi and so on. Our students got 1st place at Taluk level and participated in different games held at district level competition and won many prizes. Also we conducted fancy fest in which the students and teachers participated and enjoyed the day.

PROGRAMME:

We celebrate and conduct various programme based on the importance of the days. Likewise, this year we celebrated independence day of our nation, Teachers day, Children's day and we have

planned to celebrate suppose Christmas on 21st of this month both at school and boarding level. We also organized science exhibition in the school and it was inaugurated by Mr. Dirk from Belgium and then participated science exhibition competition at district level. As every year we get free cycles from the government for the 11th standard students, this year too we applied to the government and got 150 free cycles for the students and they were distributed by our legislative assembly member. Once in every month our teachers conduct all the subjects association which ultimately helps our students to develop their skills in the subjects.

PRIMARY SCHOOL:

ERECTION OF GATE ON BOTH SIDES OF STAIRCASE:

During break time the small kids of our primary school go to the terrace and play. Some children run up and down in the steps and sometimes it causes injuries while running. In order to stop the children going to terrace we have erected gate at both sides of the staircase. Also we repaired the children's play materials and now they are in good condition for the children to play.

ST. JOHN'S HOME:

St. John's Home for children is a home which cares a lot for the poor and needy children. There are 119 students in our home out of which 89 are boys and 29 are girls.

PREPARING GARDENS:

After the rainy season, the children were busy in preparing their own gardens. Children have planted various types of vegetables and some have started to yield production. This really helps in reducing the expense spent on vegetables.

SPORTS AND CULTURAL EVENTS:

Children possess lot of talents and they may not be knowing them. So we take initiative and provide them opportunities to realize and develop their skills in different fields. Therefore we conduct sports and cultural events in which we make sure all the children participate and exhibit their talents. Likewise, today's children are tomorrow's leaders. Keeping in view of this we organized leadership training and yoga training which helps one to get sound mind and sound body.

DEVELOPMENTAL WORKS:

Like in school we have done some developmental works in boarding too. A new chapel has been constructed and a new shed in front of our home is under construction. Mineral water plant was set up through which we get purified water for drinking. We have also replaced a new boiler to the old one which was not functioning well.

Fr. SURESH'S VISIT:

Fr. John Suresh who was the fore runner and established this great institution never fails to visit us on every Saturday and Sunday. He takes utmost care for the smooth running of this institution

Fr. JAYASEELAN:

Fr. Jayaseelan who is Rector here cooperates with us. He loves the children and cares them well. He consults with us before deciding anything.

WE GROUP:

The WE group which is an organization of student's functions well under the guide lines of Fr. Suresh and Nandini Akka. The core committee meets now and then and plans out for the future of WE. Accordingly on 23rd and 24th of November, the members of WE attended personality development training . It was really nice and helped us to know the ways to develop our personality. Also we organized fund raising programmes. We conducted volley ball tournament in memory of Dr. Clare Vellut. The tournament was inaugurated by our beloved Dirk from Belgium. We also got some catering orders for marriage functions. Some of our WE members did the catering service. From the income half of the amount was paid to the students who did the service and the rest of the amount put in WE's account. Our cultural group has contributed Rs. 10000 to the WE group.

VISITORS:

We had a few visitors from Europe. Mr. Dirk from Belgium paid a visit in the month of October and spent a week with us. Also Clara and Emmanuvel from Belgium visited us. Clara went back to Belgium after a month of stay and Emmanuvel is staying with us and he will be leaving at the end of December.

LOYOLA COLLEGE OUTREACH PROGRAM:

Students from Loyola college(one of the leading colleges in India) attended out reach camp. The camp helped them to get village experience. Nearly 150 students benefitted from this. At the end of training the students shared we could experience a new life. Since we are living in cities we were not knowing the village life.
